

Boone County DEMOGRAPHICS



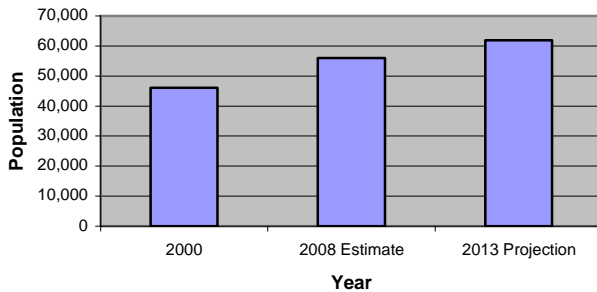
